Qualified Scrum Team Member-I teaches the core values, principles, and practices of agile product development with a focus on Scrum. You will understand the roles, events, and artefacts in the Scrum framework and will be able to work effectively as part of a cross-functional team.

Thematically, the course is geared towards beginners in agile product development, new Scrum team members, developers, future Product Owners/Scrum Masters and in general anyone who wants to understand and experience the basics of agile collaboration.

There are no prerequisites other than a willingness to learn, some preparatory reading and pre-course exercises will be provided over our online learning platform.

To gain the Qualified Scrum Team Member-I certificate, participants will need to pass an online test after the course. All related details and information will be provided during and after the course.
